Project details and supply list:

- 1 yard Pre-guilted double faced fabric solid color will need matching bobbin
- 1 3/8 yard Border fabric
- 1/3 yard Hair fabric
- Torso & Outfit Lining 1 yrd white cotton
- Micellaneous fabric & ribbon for outfits and hair accessories
- Pellon 808 Craft Fuse 1 yard (used for lining bodyparts)
- HeatnBond lite sewable 1/8 yard for shoes
- and light brown for hair)
- Threads (colors suitabe for guilted fabric, top stitching for borders, hair color and for applying velcro).

Tools:

- Sewing machine with straight stitch or applique stitch
- · Measuring tapr or long ruler
- Turing or seam creasing tool
- Walking foot is helpful due to thickness of fabric & when appliqueing doll to guilt
- Scissors
