Paper Doll Quilt

A paper doll quilt is not only a quilt but an interactive toy. Clothes and accessories are attached by hook and velcro. Not only will that special little one enjoy receiving this unique quilt, but hopefully you will find yourself experiencing great excitement in making it.

Project details and supply list:

- 1 yard Pre-quilted double faced fabric solid color - will need matching bobbin
- 1 3/8 yard Border fabric
- 1/3 yard Hair fabric
- Torso & Outfit Lining 1 yrd white cotton
- Micellaneous fabric & ribbon for outfits and hair accessories
- Pellon 808 Craft Fuse - 1 yard (used for lining bodyparts)
- HeatnBond lite sewable 1/8 yard for shoes
- Velcro sew on soft & Flexible white for torso (we have yellow, drk brown and light brown for hair)
- Threads (colors suitable for quilted fabric, top stitching for borders, hair color and for applying velcro).

Tools:

- Sewing machine with straight stitch or applique stitch
- Measuring tape or long ruler
- Turing or seam creasing tool
- Walking foot is helpful due to thickness of fabric & when appliqueing doll to quilt
- Scissors

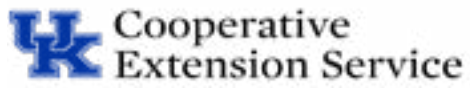
